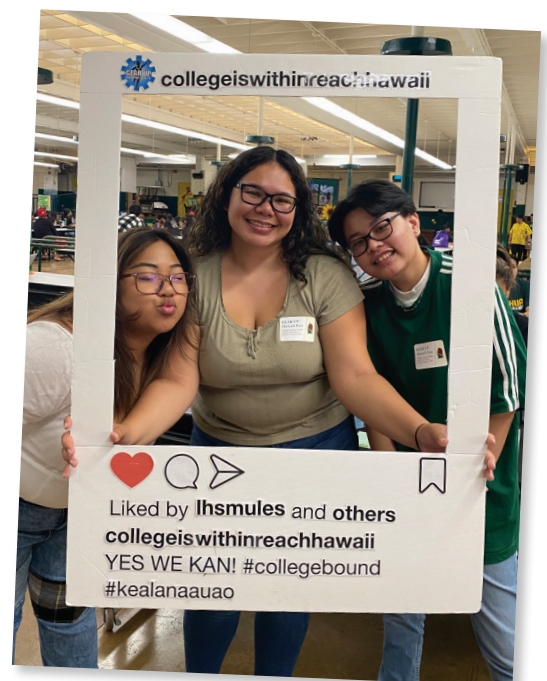
Are you planning to attend a University of Hawai'i (UH) campus right after graduating high school?

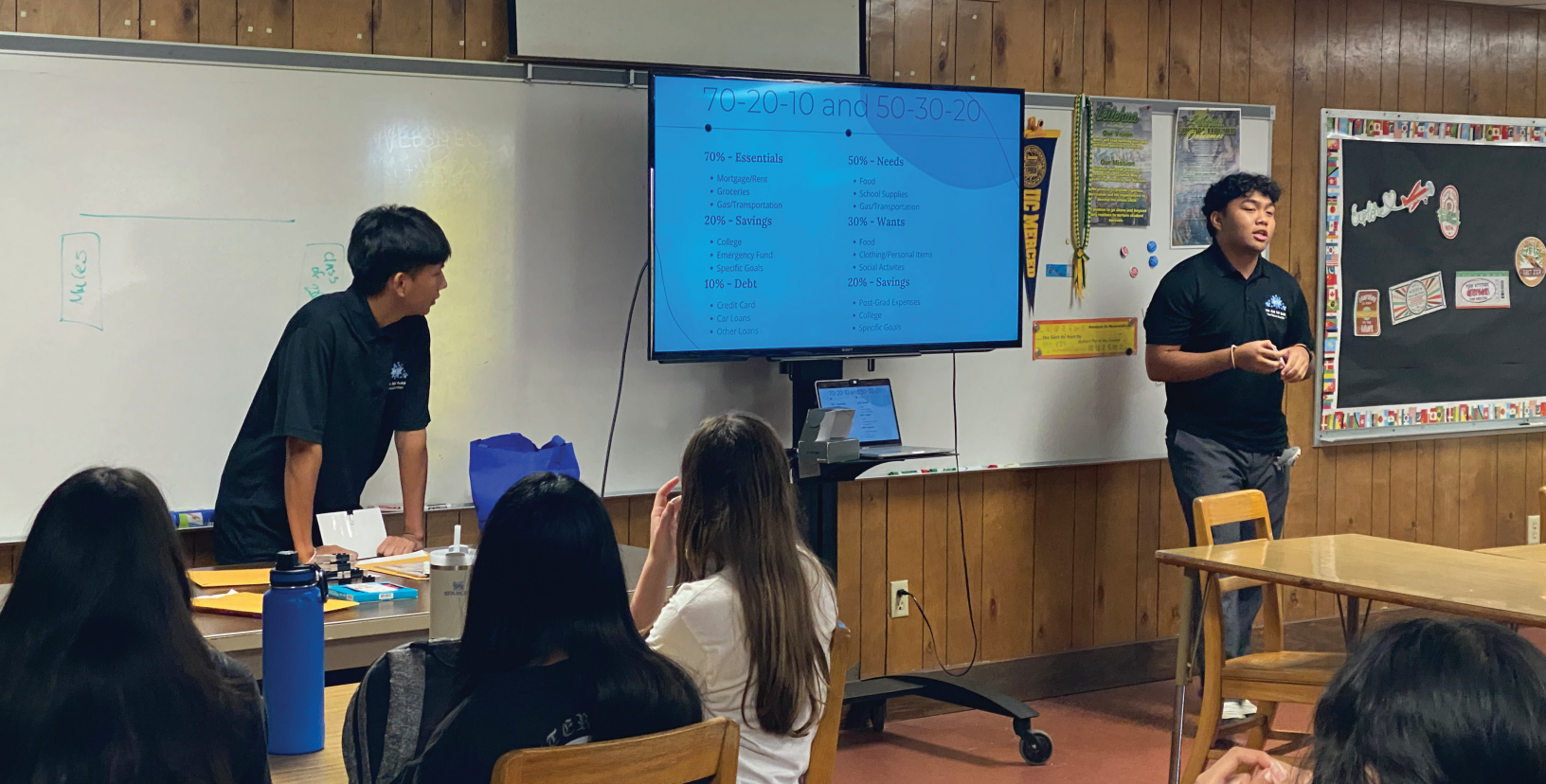
What We Do:
